



Buy tickets at GWR.com, on the GWR app, at the ticket machine on the platform at Okehampton station or from on-train staff. Through tickets are available to London, Bristol and beyond (for long distance journeys, buy in advance for the best fares).

#### DEVON AND CORNWALL RAILCARD

Costing just £12 a year, save a third on many local trips for you and a friend. Kids ride for just £1. Restrictions apply. Buy at Exeter St David's or Central (2 x ID required). Full info: dcrp.org.uk/railcard

#### GETTING TO THE STATION

The 118 bus between Tavistock, Brentor, Lydford and Okehampton calls at Okehampton station every other hour, timed with trains (Mon-Sat, some Sunday buses too). Or park at the station: £2 all day.

# **Devon & Cornwall Railcard**


- £12 gives great discounts on off peak travel for local residents for a year.
