#### One-day Travelcards live on!

Thanks to some feisty campaigning by legions of individuals and organisations including Railfuture, the deal has been done to secure this much-valued ticket.



The price to pay is a one-off price increase on Day Travelcards for travel from stations outside Zones 1-6 as part of a National Rail ticket from March 2024 (on average 3%) which will be in addition to any general regulated fares increase at the time.

### Changes to ticket retailing at stations

On 23<sup>rd</sup> October the House of Commons Transport Committee published the <u>conclusions of their inquiry</u>, including a letter of 20<sup>th</sup> October to Huw Merriman the Rail Minister asking for a response by 13<sup>th</sup> November.



The letter follows a September evidence session on proposed ticket office closures, part of a wider inquiry into the legal obligations of Accessible Transport.

### What shall we be doing this month?

- ~ holding regular online meetings of our Eastern, Kent, Herts & Beds, and Sussex & Coastway Divisions.
- ~ holding a regular online meeting of the L&SE regional branch committee.

### What has @RailfutureLSE been doing?

Since the early-October edition of *inter-railse* no.64, Railfuture's London and South East regional branch members, and / or committee members, have:

- ~ noted the passing of member John Bigny, from Edenbridge, awarded the MBE in the New Year honours announced on 31st December 2009 "For services to Edenbridge and District Rail Travellers' Association Kent." Then aged 74, he had been EDRTA Secretary for 25 years even then!
