Staffing and Station Service Warm and dry waiting and toilets at all stations with a regular service

Remove restrictions to **Network South East card**



- Connect at Ashford
- 30 minute service; 60 mph speed
- Electrified and doubled

Doubled and electrified Marshlink

- New stations
 - Start with Glyne Gap, Stone Cross
- New links and loops
 - Start with Willingdon

Build regional links from Brighton

Integrate with light rail


