
Welcome to a second festive edition

Notable timetable changes since mid-December are:

- ~ half-hourly Saturdays direct Horsham-Peterborough
- ~ all-day Monday-Saturday calls at Cooksbridge
- ~ late-evening Moorgate line reductions/alterations
- ~ two extra early-morning Overgrounds from Barking
- ~ peak Overgrounds every 6 mins to/from Stratford
- ~ first-ever Overground services on Boxing Day!

What <u>have</u> we been doing out there?

Since the early-December edition no.18 of *inter-railse* Railfuture in London and the South East has:-

Celebrated with affiliated user group Cooksbridge Area Rail Action Group on 21 December their first Saturday and all-day weekday services since May 1984!

Responded to <u>TfL's third consultation</u> on the <u>Bakerloo</u> line extension, which closed on 22 December.

Responded to South Western Railway's consultation on <u>proposed alterations to some late-night services</u>, to start December 2020, which closed on 23 December.

What shall we be doing out there?

TfSE's consultation on its <u>draft Transport Strategy</u> closes on Friday 10 January 2020.

Lewes and Eastbourne Councils' consultation on "Eastbourne's Direction of Travel: Issues and Options for the Eastbourne Local Plan 2018-38" also closes on Friday 10 January.

Standing Orders to be suspended!
