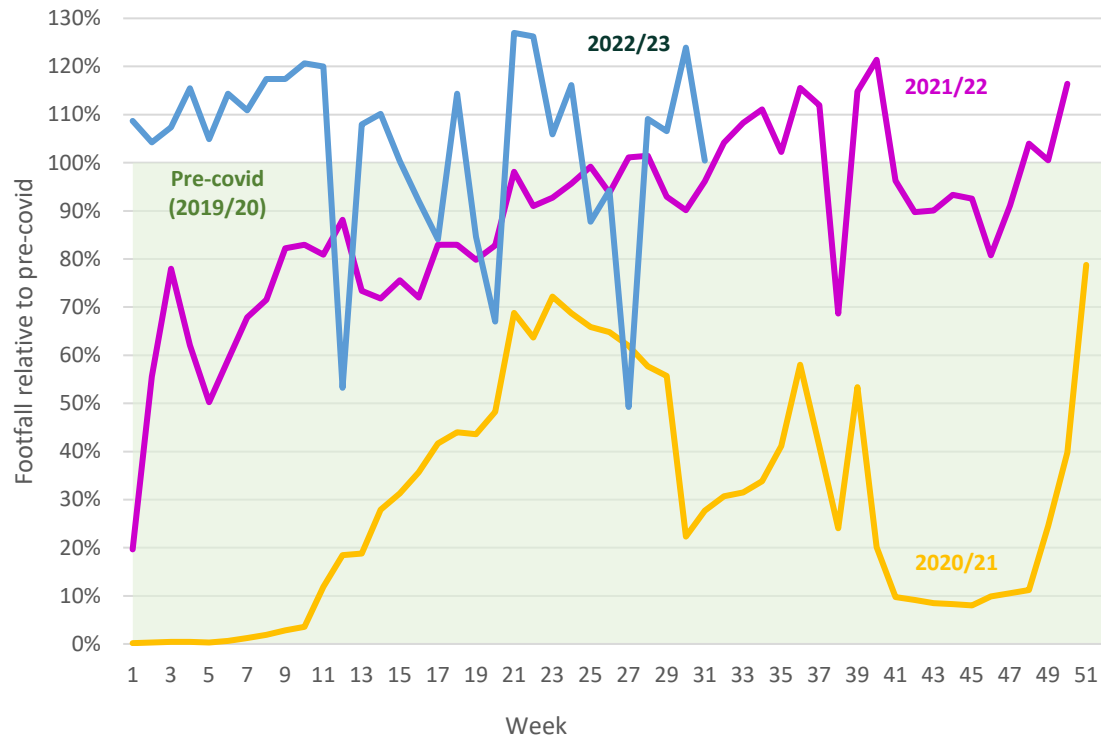

Exeter Central Gateline Usage



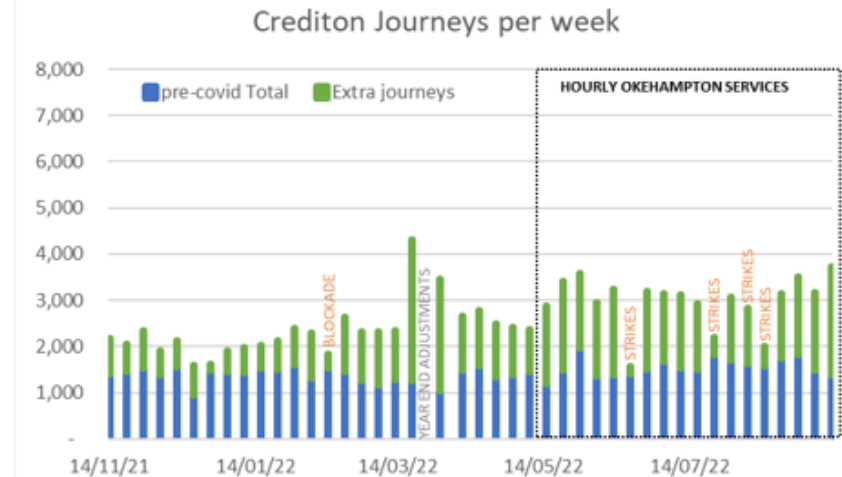
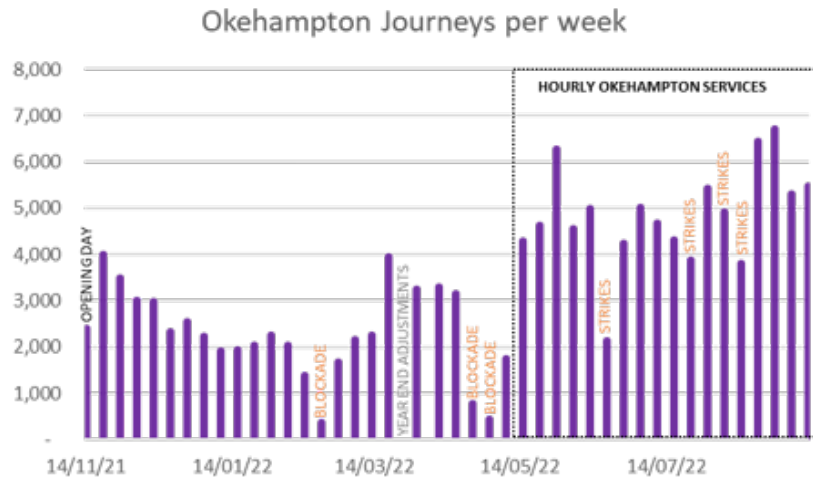
# Dartmoor Line Update

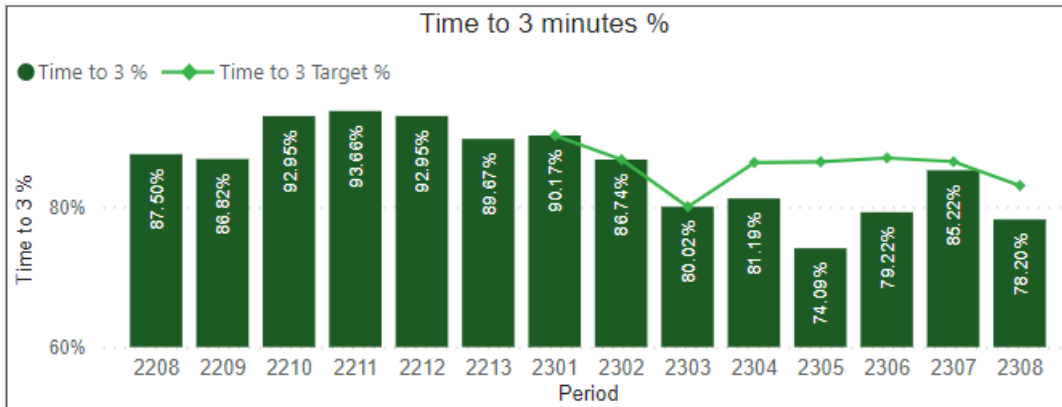

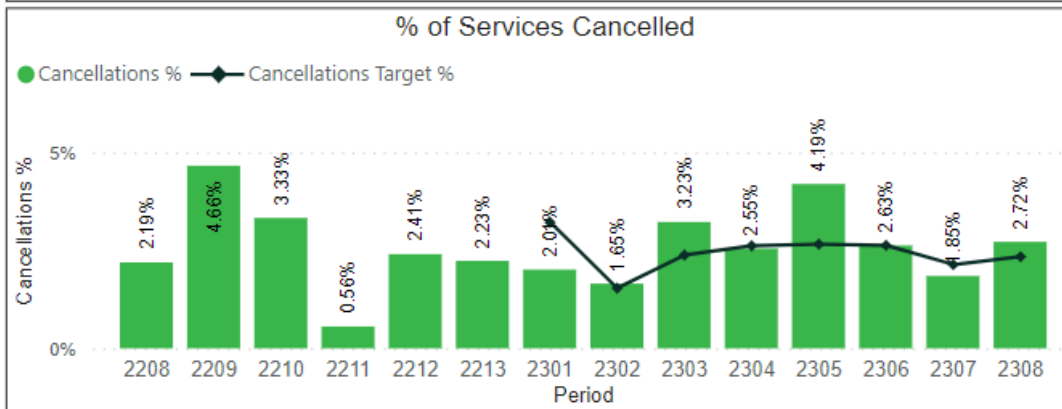
# Train Service Performance

---

- Marsh Barton new station opening 'Spring 2023'
- Continued development on the West Devon Transport Hub, Cullompton, Wellington, Edginswell new stations
- Feasibility study on Exton Waiting Shelter
- Accelerated development of Exeter Central gateline expansion
- Design work within the Station Improvement Fund pot, which covers a number of stations in Devon

# Headlines

## December 2022 Timetable Changes

---

- There will be limited timetable changes in December 2022. This is a change from past timetables
- In December we will increase the number of IETs – currently only used on London services – used by four sets. These will be used to cover Castle class (repurposed HST sets) services between Cardiff and Penzance
- The Castle Class trains will be stood down providing useful fleet/standby resilience.
- Marsh Barton - Exmouth-Paignton local services will call here and stops are included in the timetable on a suppressed basis
- Lapford – Saturday service frequency increased to mirror other days
