### **Medway Local Plan 2040**

Medway Council, a unitary authority under changed political control since May's local elections, launched consultation for its new Local Plan in mid-September. There are seven <u>local events</u> during October giving opportunities to view the proposals and talk to officers. This is our first chance since Hoo Peninsula Railway was 'paused' to re-engage with the case for that vital project given the scale of housing growth anticipated.

Since the early-September edition of *inter-railse* no.63, Railfuture's London and South East regional branch members, and / or committee members, have:

- ~ presented our "Bridge the gap" campaign on a stall at the revived Lewes Societies Fair.
- ~ submitted our response to Kent County Council's consultation on its Emerging Local Transport Plan 5.
- ~ submitted our joint response with Wessex regional branch to GTR's proposals for changes to Southern's West Coastway timetable.
- ~ contributed to a final stakeholders' workshop on Network Rail's Kent-Gatwick Connectivity Study.
- ~ participated in GWR's annual Community Rail and Stakeholders' conference.
- ~ participated in the celebrations for Kent CRP's 20th anniversary.
- ~ participated in a meeting of TfSE's Transport Forum.
- ~ participated in the Transport for the South East conference at the Amex Stadium, Falmer.
- ~ participated in the annual joint meeting of Southeast CRP's Oxted-Uckfield / East Grinstead and Tonbridge-Redhill / Reigate line steering groups.
- ~ held regular evening meetings of our Eastern and Herts & Beds Divisions online and Sussex & Coastway Division in-person in Brighton.
- ~ held a regular online meeting of the L&SE regional branch committee.
- ~ learned from Southeastern that the predecessor to Thanet Parkway station was Ebbsfleet and Cliffsend Halt, sited a short distance to the south-west, and closed after just 25 years' service on 1st April 1933;



also noted the official opening of the new station on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September by Rail Minister Huw Merriman.

# Britain's Growing Railway in London and South East: October birthdays

- ~ 3<sup>rd</sup>, in 1988 Arlesey in Central Bedfordshire, after a Before Beeching Closure (BBC) in 1959.
- ~ 5<sup>th</sup>, in 1981 Kentish Town West, after a fire a decade earlier had necessitated its closure.
- ~ 22<sup>nd</sup>, in 1988 How Wood, a new station on the Abbey Line as it was electrified.
- ~ 26<sup>th</sup>, in 2015 new Chiltern services between London Marylebone and Oxford Parkway, via the new Bicester chord and reopened stations at Islip and Bicester Village, a first glimpse of East-West Rail!

**Thursday 19 October** ORR publishes Rail infrastructure and assets 2022/23 – annual statistics covering average age of rolling stock used by passenger train operating companies and reference data on the mainline infrastructure in Great Britain.

**Sunday 29 October** Close of Planning Inspectorate's period for registering as Interested Party in the DCO for Gatwick Airport Ltd's Northern Runway project.
