What is Railfuture?

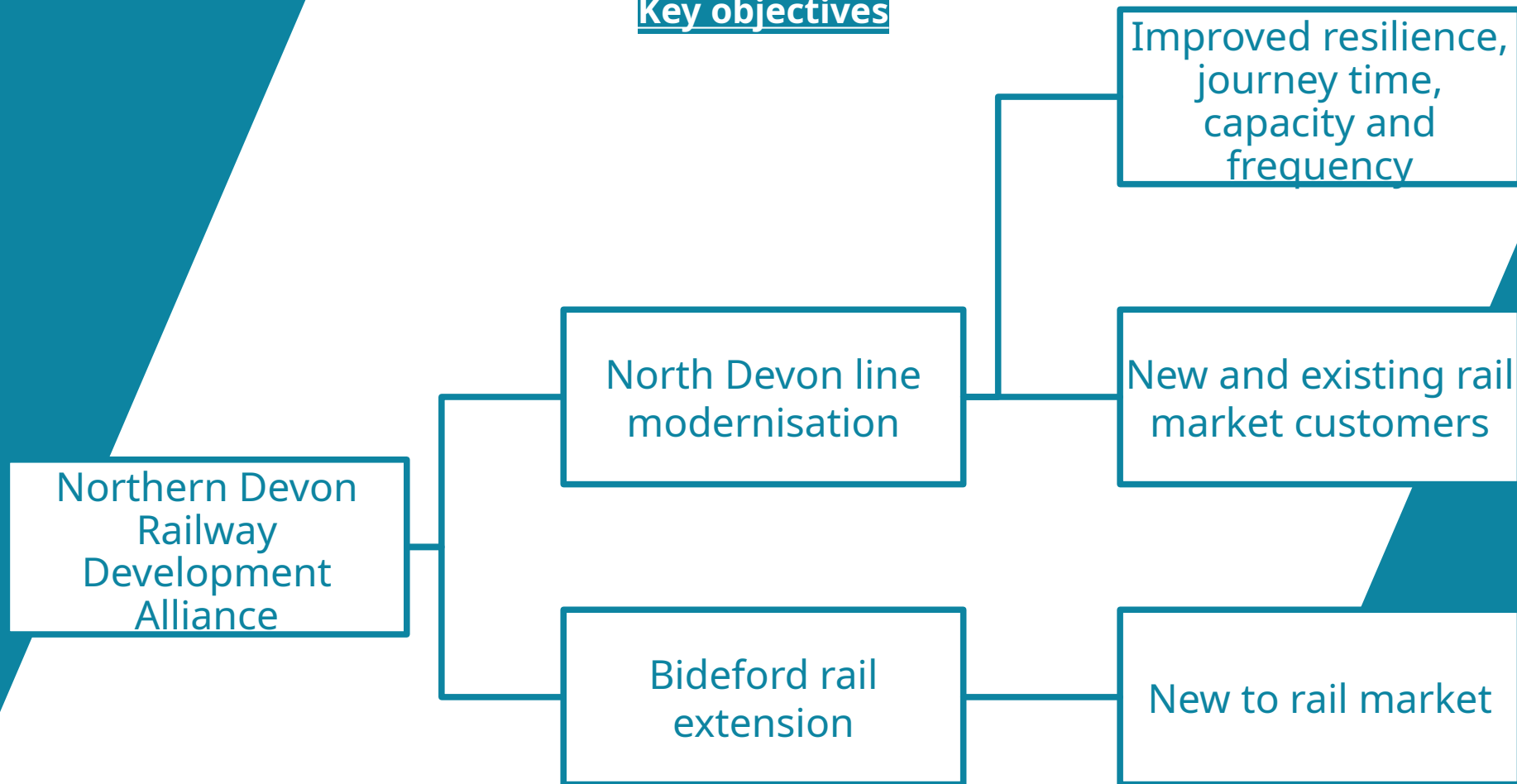
- Railfuture is Britain's leading independent organisation campaigning for a bigger better railway.

What is Railfuture supporting?

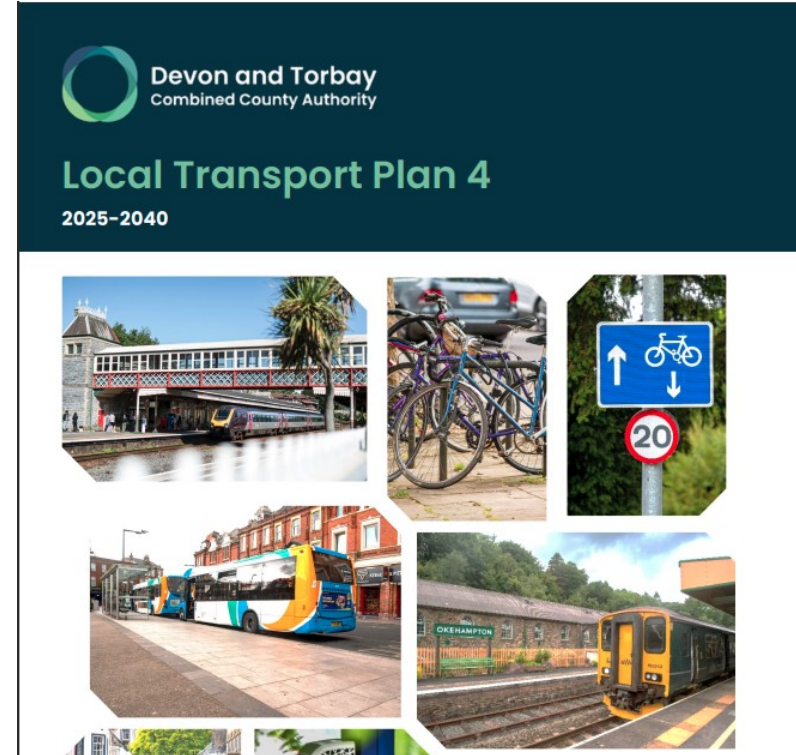
- Initiated the Northern Devon Railway Development Alliance in December 2023, first annual Convention in March 2024, second in March 2025, third to be held in March 2026 - Alliance membership is free.
- Transformational modernisation of the North Devon line – Exeter to Barnstaple passenger service. The line that services North Devon, Mid Devon and Exeter. This line is also used by Torridge, West Devon and North Cornwall residents.
- The North Devon line extension to service a new to rail market in the greater Bideford area in the Torridge district.
