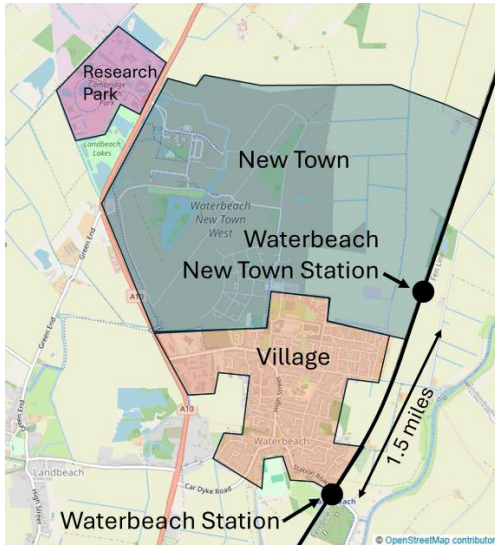


Keep Waterbeach Station Open



A new station is coming to Waterbeach

This is welcome – a modern, accessible station with lifts, cycle and car parking, and good links to walking, cycling and buses, supporting the new town.

The new station will be 1.5 miles further north

That's a significant distance from the current station serving Waterbeach village.

Closure of the existing station is proposed

The Greater Cambridge Partnership has stated it “proposes to close the existing station once it is replaced”.

The existing station should stay open

Stations this distance apart are common. The current station has recently been upgraded and serves the existing community well.

A new railway station is planned for Waterbeach New Town—and that's welcome. But the Greater Cambridge Partnership is proposing that it should replace the existing Waterbeach station, leading to its closure.

This would leave Waterbeach village and nearby communities without their local station. Around 6,000 people in Waterbeach, Landbeach and Horningsea rely on it, with nearly 400,000 journeys made each year. Most people can currently walk or cycle to the station or use its convenient parking.

The existing station provides fast, direct access to Cambridge—just minutes to Cambridge North, Central and South—supporting access to jobs, colleges and leisure. There is no quicker or more convenient way to travel.

A new station 1.5 miles to the north cannot replace this. Stations this distance apart are common across the UK, serving different communities. With the population set to grow significantly, we will need both stations.

Closing the existing station would waste recent investment and increase car use, congestion and pollution. The decision will be made by the Department for Transport and Network Rail. Please support keeping both stations open by signing the petition.
