Carbon Neutrality. Direction of travel - CN3: Public transport

Specifically to encourage more travel by rail, the Local Plan will:

- * work with Transport for the South East, East Sussex County Council, Rother District Council, Hastings Borough Council, Network Rail, Department for Transport, the Hastings & Rother Rail Users Alliance, Railfuture, and other stakeholders to secure:
- ~ direct train services between Eastbourne and London St. Pancras International via Ashford International:
- ~ a step-free interchange within Hampden Park station.

Housing Development. Direction of travel - HD1: Housing Site Allocations Summary of Issues indicates that Eastbourne cannot accommodate its Local Housing Need in full over the plan period; indicative annual build rates would need to average three times the previous 15-year annual average and four times the average annual rate for the past five years. To provide new homes, the Local Plan will also:

~ secure further suitable land for housing development by identifying in collaboration with the neighbouring authorities of Lewes and Wealden District Councils a suitable location for a new sustainable garden community between Lewes and Uckfield to be served by a new rail link between those two existing market towns and linked directly with Eastbourne, in collaboration with MHCLG, DfT, Network Rail, Transport for the South East, and East Sussex County Council.
