Happy railway birthdays in July

1973 – Stevenage. The place: designated as the UK's first New Town in 1946 under the New Towns Act, population now c.90,000. The station, Mk1: an original had opened in 1850, 1.5km north of its successor.

The station, Mk2: ranked 106th-busiset British station in 2018/19, with 4.8 million estimated entries and exits. It had been hoped that the new platform 5 would be in passenger use by now, since May's timetable. Will the station's birthday on the 23rd be opening day?

1983 – King's Cross Midland City, re-opened after closure in 1979 it was originally opened in 1863 as King's Cross Metropolitan, then re-named King's Cross Thameslink in 1988 and closed on 9 December 2007.

2011 – Southend Airport. Estimated entries and exits of 611k in 2018/19.

Our vision for rail: A railway system that provides services which travellers and freight forwarders want to use, and which offers more journey opportunities to more people and more freight.

- ~ offered our initial advice to a south London group campaigning for better local access to the rail network.
- ~ taken part in virtual meetings of some line Steering Groups of Sussex Community Rail Partnership.
- ~ held two fortnightly virtual meetings of your branch committee. Topics have included developing a draft 'prospectus' for the post-GTR era (given an added twist with recent reports of DfT / TfL discussions on Great Northern 'Metro' becoming part of London Overground), and ticketing and the future of season tickets post-pandemic.
- ~ noted that on 24 June the DfT published the results of the public consultation on <u>closing Newhaven Marine station</u>. From six days before, for less than 2 minutes: https://twitter.com/i/status/1273618521080152071
- ~ participated in the virtual quarterly meeting of the Transport Forum of Transport for the South East, addressing two 'Cs' Covid and carbon. TfSE's Transport Strategy is due for adoption on 16th July, and our Sussex & Coastway Division on Thursday 23rd July will receive an update presentation. See S&C Division.
- ~ been unable to attend a parish council meeting in East Sussex due to the pandemic lockdown. They had invited us to visit and explain our view of prospects for a new rail link between Uckfield and Lewes.

What shall we be doing (remotely)?

1 June 2020 "Unblocking the Croydon bottleneck" – Network Rail are now into the second round of public consultation on Croydon Area Remodelling Scheme, until Sunday 20 September. No public events likely until September so a telephone hotline available until mid-July, after the live June weekday chat sessions.
