What shall we be doing this month?

~ finalising our response to the survey from Transport for the South East in preparation for the refresh of its Transport Strategy, which closes on Sunday 2 June.



~ finalising our response to Central Bedfordshire Council on their pre-draft Local Transport Plan consultation, which will close on Sunday 30 June.



~ holding regular meetings of our Herts & Beds and Sussex & Coastway Divisions **online**.

~ holding a regular **online** meeting of L&SE regional branch's committee.
