With the whole country going to the polls on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July, Railfuture nationally has this time opted for a Question and Answer format communicated via our social media outlets, rather than a written manifesto. Our original 10-point plan was published in February.

~ finalising our response to Central Bedfordshire Council on their pre-draft Local Transport Plan consultation, which will close on Sunday 30 June.



- ~ holding regular meetings of our Herts & Beds and Sussex & Coastway Divisions online.
- ~ holding a regular online meeting of L&SE regional branch's committee.

Our vision for Railfuture: An independent organisation whose views are respected by the rail industry, to which decision makers come for advice, which rail users are proud to join and recommend.


### What has @RailfutureLSE been doing?
